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POSTION: Director/Member at Large

POSTION OVERVIEW: The office of Director/Member at Large is an elected position, designed for the mentoring and development of new board members to become futures leaders of the organization. The Director/Member at Large will represent the interests of the membership at large, regardless of the segment of membership from which he/she may come from or his/her own point of view. The major responsibility will be to determine the wants and needs of the membership and bring these to the attention of the board in order to build a stronger Chapter, which reflects the current and future needs of the members and profession. This position is limited to two consecutive terms.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Participates and is a voting member on the Board of Directors.
- Reports to the Board of Directors information relevant to membership growth and development.
- Makes recommendation to the Board of Directors on educational, recruitment, networking, mentoring opportunities to increase exposure and understanding of the chapter and its benefits.
- Performs other duties as directed by the Board of Directors.
- During each term of office the Director/Member at Large will be assigned to act as a Board Liaison to a CMSNE Committee as assigned by the Board of Directors
- If unable to perform the duties of the office, the Director/Member at Large will resign or be terminated from the position in accordance with Article VII, Officers, Section 6, Removal, of the chapter bylaws.

- Invitation to Board retreats, as sponsored/offered by CMSNE
- Based on program attendance and/or demand for Board presence, complimentary registration may be extended for programs sponsored by the Chapter and/or Chapter Extensions. The Board member agrees to actively greet participants, networks with participants and program sponsors, participates in registration activities and/or facilitates table discussions or other program components as assigned.
- Increased networking opportunities with Corporate and program sponsors and peers
- Development of communication, leadership and public relations skills

For programs sponsored by the Chapter, decisions regarding complimentary registration are made by the President and Program Chairperson.
