Member Discount Qualifications

In order to qualify for the CMSA Membership Discount, the individual must meet the following criteria:

- Has been a CMSA Member for 3 or more years
- Has recently retired or become disabled
- Retired members must be 59 ½ years or older
- Has been a member of CMSA within the last 2 years
- Agreement to participate on a CMSNE committee or be active in the organization in some way. (Please see reverse side and identify an opportunity where you would like to volunteer your expertise.)
