- MA 3 bills and RI 1 bill have active legislation to be heard this July 2022 for eNLC testimony
- New Public Policy posters **Telehealth Legislation** and **New Workplace Violence Regulations** to be presented at CMSA Annual in Orlando June 2022 both virtually and live in person by committee members
- Will present CMSNE webinar on 6/22/22 on **New Workplace Violence Regulations**
- Active with the tMed Telehealth Committee Massachusetts Hospital Association for Mass Telehealth legislation to be heard this July 2022
